CONTRACT—STATE WITH THE GINN ELECTRIC COMPANY,  
ELECTRICAL WORK, DIVISION 5, ITEM XX, WOMEN'S  
DORMITORIES, OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY, COLUMBUS.

HON. CARL G. WAHL, *Director, Department of Public Works, Columbus, Ohio.*

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval, a contract by and between The Ginn Electric Company, an Ohio Corporation, acting through you as Director of the Department of Public Works for the Board of Trustees of Ohio State University, for the construction and completion of the electrical work (Division 5—Item XX) for the Women's Dormitories on the campus of the Ohio State University, as set forth in Form of Proposal dated February 11, 1939, and which contract calls for an expenditure of \$12,930.00.

You have submitted the following papers in this connection: Division of Contract; Notice to bidders and Proof of Publication; Tabulation of bids; Form of Proposal containing contract bond signed by the Seaboard Surety Company of New York, as surety and with the authority of the signer of said bond and certificate of compliance with insurance laws pertaining to surety companies; affixed thereto; Workmen's Compensation Certificate showing that The Ginn Electric Company has complied with laws relative to workmen's compensation.

You have submitted in this connection, the official proceedings of the Board of Trustees of Ohio State University, which records provide that

the construction of this project be financed in part through the provisions of Senate Bill No. 492 (92nd General Assembly), by the issuance of bonds and said funds from the sale of bonds to be deposited in the University Dormitory Fund, and said project to be financed in part by a WPA grant.

These records also contain the WPA approval of awarding of contract; the Recommendation of the University Architect and the recommendations of the University Cabinet, and the recommendation of the Director of the Department of Public Works; Letter of certification from the Auditor of State showing that all necessary papers and documents are on file in his office.

Finding said contract in proper legal form, I am returning said contract together with all papers submitted in this connection, with my approval noted thereon.
