APPROVAL, THREE LEASES TO RESERVOIR LAND AT BUCKEYE LAKE, OHIO—WILLIAM SCHNEIDER—A. C. WALTERS.

DEAR SIR:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a recent communication from your department over the signature of the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks in the Conservation Division, submitting for my examination and approval three certain reservoir land leases in triplicate, executed by William H. Reinhart, Conservation Commissioner, by which there are leased and demised to the respective lessees therein named, for terms of fifteen years each, certain parcels of reservoir land at Buckeye Lake, which parcels of land are fully described in said respective leases.

The leases here in question, designated with respect to the names of the respective lessees and the appraised valuations of the lands leased, are as follows:

Upon examination of said leases, each of which calls for an annual rental of six per centum upon the appraised valuation of the parcel of land leased, I find that the same have been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by the respective lessees therein named.
