DEAR SIR: This is to acknowledge receipt of your recent communication with which you submit for my examination and approval a certain lease by the H. W. Riddle Estate to the State of Ohio acting through you as Director of the Department of Public Works for the Bureau of Unemployment Compensation.

By this lease which is one for the term commencing on the first day of December, 1939, and ending on the 31st day of December, 1940, there are leased and demised certain premises to the State for the use of the Bureau of Unemployment Compensation, described as follows:
