DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval a contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Public Works, for the Board of Trustees of the Ohio State University, Columbus, Ohio, and Pearl Sloop of Columbus, Ohio. This contract covers the construction and completion of General Contract (Items 1-8, inclusive) for Remodeling Robinson Laboratory on the campus of Ohio State University, in accordance with the form of proposal dated November 20, 1931. Said contract calls for an expenditure of three thousand two hundred and ninety-eight dollars (\$3,298.00).

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract. You have produced evidence to show that the Emergency Board has released from the Emergency Fund, moneys sufficient to cover the amount of this contract. In addition, you have submitted a contract bond, upon which the Union Indemnity Company of New Orleans, Louisiana, appears as surety, sufficient to cover the amount of the contract.

You have further submitted evidence indicating that plans were properly prepared and approved, notice to bidders was given, bids tabulated as required
