DEAR SIR:---Under date of June 8, 1933, the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks in the Conservation Division in your department, submitted for my examination and approval two certain reservoir land leases in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner to James F. Demaris and W. Demaris, respectively, both of Columbus, Ohio.

By the leases here in question each of which is for the stated term of fifteen years and each of which provide for an annual rental of twelve dollars, payable semi-annually, there are granted and demised to said respective lessees certain contiguous parcels of state reservoir land on the westerly embankment of Indian Lake, near Stubb's Landing, at Lakeview, Ohio, which parcels of land are more particularly described in said respective leases.

Upon examination of these leases, I find that each of the same has been properly executed by the lessee therein named and by the Conservation Commissioner. I further find upon examination of the provisions of said leases and of the conditions and instructions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, and other Sections of the General Code, which in one way or another relate to leases of this kind. I am accordingly approving these leases as to legality and form as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon these leases and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are returned.
