Dear Sir :-You have submitted for my examination an abstract of title, warranty deed, encumbrance estimate and Controlling Board's certificate relative to the purchase of 150 acres of land in Franklin Township, Wayne County, from the estate of W. P. Snyder, which premises are more particularly described as follows:
"The East part of the Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-three (23), Township Fifteen (15), Range Thirteen (13), beginning for the same 2 chains and 5 links East of the Northwest corner of said quarter where a Hickory $6^{\prime \prime}$ bears North 4 degrees West 18 links; thence East on the North line of said quarter 37 chains and 47 links to the Northeast corner of said quarter; thence South on the East line of the quarter 39 chains and 53 links to the Southeast corner of said quarter; thence West on the South line of said quarter 37 chains and 82 links to a post where a White Oak 22" bears North 27 EG and which is 2 chains and 5 links East of the Southwest corner of said quarter ; thence North and parallel with the West line of the quarter 40 chains and 16 links to the place of beginning containing ONE HUNDRED FIFTY (150) ACRES or land.
