APPROVAL—GRANTS OF EASEMENT EXECUTED TO THE
STATE OF OHIO BY SEVERAL PROPERTY OWNERS IN
GRANGE TOWNSHIP, MORGAN COUNTY, OHIO.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio, by several property owners in Orange Township, Delaware County, and Penn Township, Morgan County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said township and counties.

The grants of easement here in question, designated with respect to the number of the instrument, the location of the land by township and county, and the name of the grantor, are as follows:
