SALE—STATE TO GILBERT S. HAMILTON, DESIGNATED PORTION, OHIO CANAL LANDS, VILLAGE OF FRAZEYS-BURG, MUSKINGUM COUNTY.

DEAR SIR: You recently submitted for my examination and approval a transcript of your proceedings relating to the sale to one Gilbert S. Hamilton, of Frazeysburg, Ohio, for the sum of \$3.00, a portion of the Ohio Canal lands in the Village of Frazeysburg, Ohio, which was vacated and abandoned for canal purposes by Act of June 7, 1911, 102 Ohio Laws 293, and which land is more particularly described as follows:

"Beginning at a point in the west line of an alley that runs north and south and parallel with West Street in said village, said point being where said alley intersects with the westerly property line of the abandoned Ohio and Erie Canal; thence southerly along the west line of said alley produced thirty-five (35') feet, more or less; to the south line of Lot No. 6, of the John Bagent Addition to said village; thence westerly along the south line of said lot thirty (30') feet, more or less, to the westerly line of said canal property; thence northeasterly along said canal property line, forty-six (46') feet, more or less, to the point of beginning and containing five hundred twenty-five (525) square feet, more or less."

It appears that you are authorized to sell the tract of land by reason of this and other related acts concerning abandoned canal lands for the appraised value thereof above stated. And finding, as I do, that your proceedings relating to the sale of this property are in all respects regular and in conformity with the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly above noted, and other related provisions of the General Code of Ohio, I am approving this transcript, and the sale of this tract of land evidenced thereby, as appears by my approval endorsed upon the transcript and upon the duplicate copy thereof, both of which are herewith enclosed.
