DEAR SIR:—You have submitted to me for approval a contract (four copies) between the Department of Highways and Public Works of the State of Ohio and Westinghouse Electric & Manufacturing Company of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. This contract is for the construction of a switchboard in the new power house on the Ohio State University campus, and calls for an expenditure of fourteen thousand, three hundred and fifty-eight (\$14,358.00) dollars.
