APPROVAL, CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STATE OF OHIO AND THE ELECTRIC POWER AND EQUIPMENT COMPANY, COLUMBUS, OHIO, FOR COMPLETION OF ELECTRICAL WORK FOR ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY, AT A COST OF \$5,600.00—SURETY BOND EXECUTED BY THE GLOBE INDEMNITY COMPANY.

DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Highway and Public Works, and The Electric Power & Equipment Company, an Ohio corporation of Columbus, Ohio. This contract relates to the completion of the electrical work for the administration building, of the Ohio State University, and calls for an expenditure of \$5,600.00.

A contract bond has been submitted to insure the faithful performance of the contract, upon which the Globe Indemnity Company appears as surety.

Certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in the sum of \$5,600.00 has been submitted.

Evidence has also been submitted indicating that plans were prepared and approved, bids properly tabulated and notice to bidders legally given. Evidence has further been submitted indicating that the requirements of the law relative to the status of insurance companies and the industrial compensation have been complied with.
