Narrative:

On Tuesday, April 05, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Butterworth (SA Butterworth) compiled background information on Rayshawn Meeks (Meeks), a subject involved in the incident on March 7, 2022. The information included researching past police reports involving the subject, searching criminal history records, court records (if applicable), open/closed-source database inquiries, and social media posts. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit and the Columbus Police Department.

SA Butterworth reviewed the information and noted the following:

Prior Police Encounters:

According to Columbus Police Department (CPD) records, Meeks has been named in several encounters with CPD. Incidents where Meeks was named in the records included the following: Rape (2004); Assault, Felony Theft (X2); Theft from a motor vehicle (2005); Gross Sexual Imposition, Assault, Miscellaneous Incident listed as missing juvenile issue (2006); miscellaneous incident listed as banned from a convenience store, (2008); Drug Offense (crack cocaine possession), DUS, tampering and CCW, possession of crack cocaine, (2009). Meeks was listed as a passenger in a vehicle involved in a traffic crash in January of 2021.

The Franklin County Sheriff's Office did not have any records reported to SA Butterworth involving Meeks.

Narrative

On 3/24/2009 at 5:07pm Officers Trask and Freetage working CPD wagon 128 observed the defendant, Rayshawn S Meeks walk out of the Family Market on the corner of E Livingston Ave and S 22nd St. The area is a high crime drug and gang area. Both Officers knew Mr. Meeks from previous encounters with him and that he is a documented 22nd St Bloods gang member. Both officers knew that Mr Meeks had a warrant for Pedestrian Sudden Crossing. Officers stopped Mr. Meeks and informed him that he had a warrant and that he was under arrest. Officer Freetage placed Mr. Meeks in handcuffs. Officer Trask conducted a search incident to arrest of Mr Meeks and found in his left shoe a rock of

crack cocaine. Mr Meeks shouted out, "Thats not crack, its gum." The cocaine was tested with a field test kit and it came back blue positive for cocaine. Officers transported Mr Meeks to 12 sub 950 E. Main St. and was read his Constitutional Rights by Officer Trask, which he waived. Mr Meeks said that he is a crack addict and that he uses crack on a regular basis. He also stated that he does not sell crack and that he did not know he had it on him. Mr. Meeks would not tell Officer Trask where he gets his crack and he would not give up any names. Mr Meeks was transported to CPD headquarters ID and slated at Franklin County Jail on the listed charges. The crack cocaine was turned into the property room and a lab request was submitted.

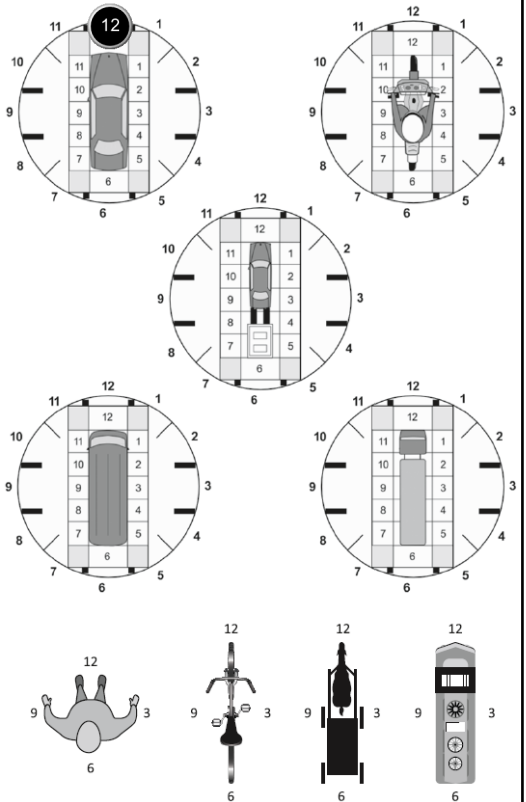

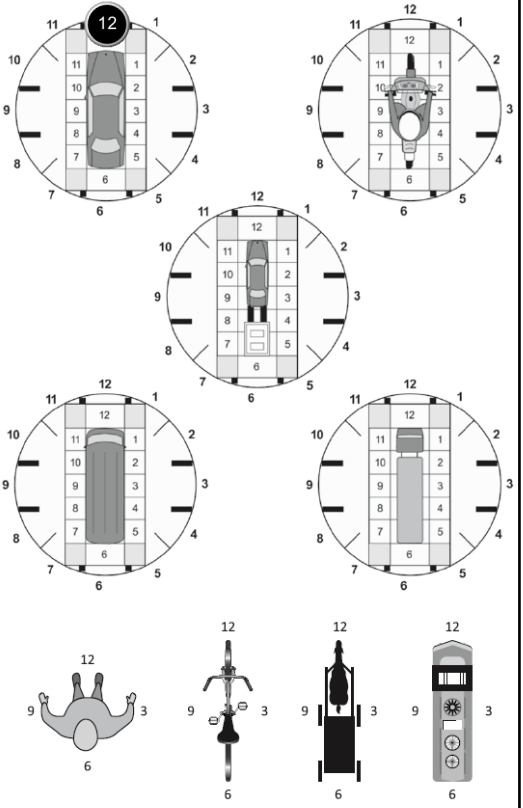

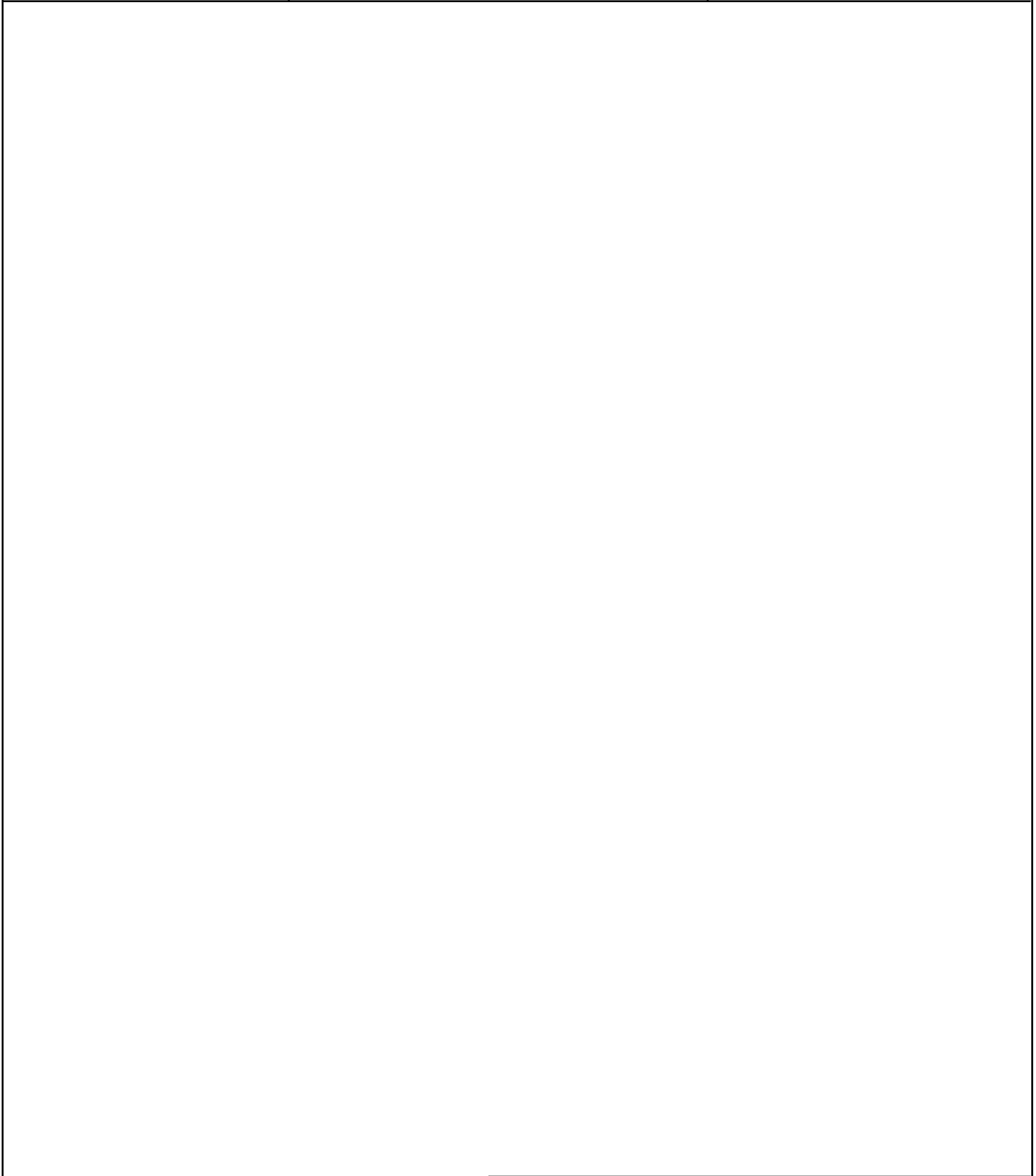

Narrative

On 06-18-09 at approximately 11:45pm Officers assigned to the summer gang task force were traveling northbound on S 22nd from Livingston Ave. This particular area is a high crime area and multiple complaints were received from residents in the area and 11 precinct patrol officers for shots being fired, and other gang activity. While officers were on S 22nd St, officers observed approximately (13) males and females in the street and surrounding a maroon vehicle that was parked in front of 668 S 22nd St. As officers got closer to the vehicle, Officer Slivanya observed a male with a red T-shirt and black jeans who was later identified as Rayshawn Meeks, break away from the group he was with, and start walking in the opposite direction that officers. As Slivanya exited the vehicle and began to walk on the sidewalk, Mr. Meeks observed Slivanya walking on the sidewalk towards him and he began to panic, Mr. Meeks turned away from Slivanya quickly and stuffed his hands down the front of his pants as if he was concealing an object. As Slivanya closed in on Mr. Meeks, he pulled his hands from his waistband and dropped a loaded Clerk-Techni Corp .22 revolver with (1) live round in the chamber, serial#306075 to the ground where he was standing. Slivanya was able to place Mr. Meeks on the ground and he was secured with handcuffs. Officer Steele noted there was four spent casing in the cylinder along with one live round possibly indicating shots were fired from the gun recently.

The firearm was ran through LEADS by officers and it came back negative for being stolen. At this point other officers from the gang task force unit arrived on scene to assist in the arrest and to conduct field interviews on the other males Mr. Meeks was with. Officer from the task force also recovered one large bag of marijuana, and several smalls bags. The marijuana was transported to the property room by Officer Best for evidence. The firearm was transported to the CPD property room by Officers Nerweski and Sanderson and it was stored as evidence.

Officers Slivanya and Steele then transported Mr. Meeks to Headquarters I.D. unit and to the 6th floor for further processing. While on the 6th floor, Steele read Mr. Meeks his constitutional rights form in the presence of Slivanya and Mr. Meeks waived his rights and made the following statement: He stated that the gun was not his and he knows who threw the gun to the ground. Mr. Meeks would not advise officers who the person was who threw the gun and he made no other statements to officers. Mr. Meeks advised he left from his "Aunties" residence to go the store when he was stopped by his friends. He did admit to smoking a "Blunt" and then the police showed up. Mr. Meeks added he was only grabbing for his cellphone and it wasn't him with the gun.

Mr. Meeks was charged with carrying a concealed weapon, and tampering with evidence and he was transported to the Franklin County Jail by the listed officers.

Note: Mr. Meeks is a documented " Deuce Deuce" Gang member by the Columbus Police Gang unit and Mr. Meeks has several violent convictions on his BCI printout. It is requested that Mr. Meeks has a high bong due to his past and being an active gang member.

Narrative

On 1/27/09 at 3:36P PO M Baase #1741 was working CPD Marked Cruiser #124 and was patrolling the area of E Livingston Ave and S 22nd St when he observed the defendant, Rayshawn S Meeks, wearing a green jacket and green baseball style hat standing on the sidewalk on the South side of E Livingston Ave West of S 22nd St. At this time of day, traffic on E Livingston Ave is and was heavy heading E/B. As PO Baase watched, Mr Meeks stepped out onto E Livingston

Ave and took two steps before turning and seeing the police cruiser at the corner. When seeing the cruiser, Mr Meeks appeared shocked as his eyes went wide. Mr Meeks quickly hurried back out of the street onto the sidewalk. PO Baase pulled along side Mr Meeks and activated his overhead beacons, which activated the Officer's Cruiser Video Systems. PO Baase exited the cruiser and approached Mr Meeks. As he did, Mr Meeks continued walking several steps and his eyes darted back and forth. When the officer got closer, Mr Meeks began moving his arms backwards and taking several steps back, trying to distance himself from the officer. Believing that Mr Meeks was attempting to distance himself from the officer and possibly concealing something in his hands, PO Baase immediately asked Mr Meeks if he had anything, being weapons, on his person that the officer needed to know about. Mr Meeks stepped back again and stated that he did not. Due to Mr Meeks actions, PO Baase took hold of Mr Meeks right wrist to ensure he would not flee or present a weapon and informed Mr Meeks that he was being detained for Stepping Into the Street. Mr Meeks stated that he only took "a couple" of steps into the street before seeing a bus coming his direction. Mr Meeks immediately began stating that his pedestrian violation was not important. PO Baase asked Mr Meeks if he could search his person. Mr Meeks stated that he did not have anything on his person and gave consent for the officer to search him. PO Baase searched Mr Meeks person after being given consent. Inside of the rim of Mr Meeks hat, PO Baase first located a single loose rock of Crack Cocaine. At that point, PO Baase placed Mr Meeks in the rear of his cruiser. Going back to Mr Meeks hat, PO Baase then located two rocks of Crack Cocaine inside a clear plastic baggie also concealed in the rim of the hat. Mr Meeks was informed that he was now under arrest for Possession of Crack Cocaine.

At this point, Mr Meeks began claiming that the hat the narcotics were found in was not his. Mr Meeks claimed that the hat did not belong to him, but that he had been wearing it for a week's time. Mr Meeks claimed no knowledge of the Crack Cocaine found on his person. While PO Baase completed the arrest paperwork, Mr Meeks claimed a wide spectrum of accounts of what had happened. Mr Meeks claimed that he stepped into the street, then saw a bus and hurried back to the sidewalk. Mr Meeks also stated that he only took one step out into the street. After some time, Mr Meeks reversed his story stating that he was never in the street and that he simply had slipped on the ice and put a foot into the street. All of Mr Meeks' contradictory and false statements were recorded on the Cruiser Video System. Before PO Baase could read Mr Meeks his Constitutional Rights Waiver, Mr Meeks stated that wanted to talk to his lawyer. However, after approximately an hour and forty-five minutes of processing, Mr Meeks admitted, unprompted by the officer, that he did step into the street. PO Baase told Mr Meeks that the truth would help him in the long run of the criminal justice process. PO's Freetage and Clutter assisted PO Baase in the processing of Mr Meeks' arrest. Mr Meeks identity was verified through CPD ID Bureau and L.E.A.D.S. The Crack Cocaine was turned in to the CPD Property Room for evidence and testing (#09001717.) Check of Records returned an active warrant for Mr Meeks arrest for a 2008 Pedestrian Use of Sidewalk charge. Mr Meeks was processed through CPD ID Bureau and Slated at FCJ. PO Baase also turned in the green baseball hat that Mr Meeks was wearing and concealing the crack cocaine inside to CPD Property Room. Mr Meeks was cited for his Pedestrian-Stepping into the Street violation.

On June 6, 2006 Detective Victoria Fullen #1339 interviewed alleged child victim, Cemika Wilson. The interview took place at the Rosemont Center where Cemika is a resident.

Cemika stated that she was 14 years old and that her birthday is 12/24/1991. She stated that she attends Franklin Middle School and plans to attend South or Marion Franklin High School in the fall.

Cemika confirmed that she had been pregnant and that the father of her child was Rayshaun Meek. She stated that she met him in the area of Parsons and Livingston Avenue. She also stated that she was in jail for a probation violation and she did not know how old she was.

Cemika stated that she was fourteen when she met the suspect. She stated that she met him at a store at 22nd and Livingston Ave. This differs from her earlier statement. She stated that they met in August at the beginning of 8th grade. She stated that she was going into the store and that the suspect kept trying to talk to her. She stated that they walked to Children's Hospital Park to talk.

According to the victim she and the suspect had sex at Will's house and in an abandoned house. She stated that Will's house is on Livingston Ave but did not have any other information. She stated that the abandoned house was at Carpenter and Sycamore. She stated that she thought it was brown and that it was being remodeled.

Cemika stated that she and the suspect had sex about ten times. According to her they would just run into each other when this would happen. She stated that the suspect didn't know how old she was and that he didn't ask. She stated that the baby was due in November and that the suspect didn't know she was pregnant.

Cemika also stated that she had been sexually active prior to her relationship with the suspect. She stated that her first sexual encounter was with Rayshaun and happened in November. She stated that they used a condom the first two times and the rest of the times they didn't.

Cemika stated she also has sex with another male named Rayshaun aka Chase Henderson 17years old. She stated they had sex in April 2006. She stated that they met at a friend's house.

Cemika also stated that she had sex with Mike a sixteen year old she met at the skating rink. She stated that this happened in October 2005 but later stated that she got the months mixed up and doesn't know when it happened. She stated that school was in and that they used a condom. She initially stated that they had sex at her house and they stated it happened at her cousin's house on Carpenter.

Summary of Findings

The victim was interviewed and gave history of a consensual sexual relationship with the suspect that resulted in a pregnancy. She also gave history of engaging in sexual conduct with three other age appropriate males. The victim had a molar pregnancy that in layman's terms means at conception it began as a normal pregnancy but the fetus never developed and a mass of tissue grew instead. The victim was hospitalized and the tissue was removed. The suspect was located at the Franklin County Court House and DNA was collected from him. He also denied having a sex with the victim. The DNA from both the parties and the tissue sample from the pregnancy were turned in for comparison however a comparison could not be made. The victim and her family have stopped cooperating with the investigation and the victim stated she would not cooperate in prosecution.
