DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval contract between the State of Ohio, acting through the Department of Highways and Public Works, and Paul L. Gilmore of Columbus, Ohio. This contract covers the electrical work for the Medical Science Building on the Ohio State University Campus and calls for an expenditure of \$6,500.00.

You have submitted a contract bond upon which the Fidelity and Casualty Company of New York appears as surety, which bond is sufficient to cover the amount stated in said contract. There has further been submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated sufficient to cover the obligations of this contract.
