APPROVAL, THREE CONTRACTS BETWEEN THE STATE OF OHIO AND PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD FOR GRADE CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS IN NOBLE, FAYETTE AND JEFFERSON COUNTIES.

DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval, three proposed contracts between the State of Ohio and the Pennsylvania Railroad Company, relating to the following improvements:

Elimination of the grade crossing over the tracks of the Pennsylvania Railroad on State Highway No. 353, located about three-quarters of a mile north of Coal Ridge in Noble County, Ohio.

Elimination of the grade crossing over the tracks of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company on State Highway No. 10, located about four-tenths of a mile east of Johnson, in Fayette County, Ohio.

Reconstruction of a separated crossing used by the Pennsylvania Railroad Company, lessee of and operating the Pittsburgh, Cincinnati, Chicago and St. Louis Railroad on the extension of State (Intercounty) Highway No. 7, State Route No. 7, located within the corporate limits of Steubenville, Jefferson County, Ohio, at the junction of Wells street and Poplar avenue.

After examination it is my opinion that the proposed contracts are in proper legal form and when executed, will constitute a valid contract.
