BUCKEYE LAKE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, ANNUAL
RENTAL \$24.00 EACH PARCEL, TERM FIFTEEN YEARS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval, two reservoir land leases executed by you as Conservation Commissioner to the lessee therein named, by which there were leased and demised to the lessee therein named parcels of reservoir land owned by the State of Ohio at Buckeye Lake, Ohio.

These leases, designated as to the name of the lessee, the locations of the parcels of land leased, and the annual rental provided for therein, are as follows:
