Narrative:

On Tuesday, June 07, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Shane Hanshaw (SA Hanshaw) received the personnel file for Deputy [REDACTED] from Washington County Sheriff's Office (WCSO) Captain Bryan Lockhart. SA Hanshaw reviewed the training portion of the personnel file and noted the following:

- On November 19, 2008, Deputy [REDACTED] completed the Ohio Full-Service Facility Corrections Officer Basic Training Program. The training was conducted by Muskingum County Corrections Academy.
 - o Deputy [REDACTED] was hired as a Washington County Sheriff's Office Corrections Officer in 2008.
 - o Deputy [REDACTED] served as a Corrections Officer, Sergeant Corrections Officer, and Lieutenant Corrections Officer within the Washington County Sheriff's Office.
 - o Throughout Deputy [REDACTED]'s service as a Corrections Officer, Deputy [REDACTED] obtained multiple additional training certificates in the field of Corrections.
- On January 22, 2019, Deputy [REDACTED] completed the Ohio Peace Officer Basic Training Program.
 - o On October 29, 2018, Deputy [REDACTED] completed the Speed Measuring Device Operators Course. The training was conducted by the Ohio State Highway Patrol.

- o On May 10, 2021, Deputy ██████ completed annual firearms requalification for the Washington County Sheriff's Office. Deputy ██████ qualified with multiple firearms including the current MP 2.0 9mm, serial number ██████ that was used during the Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI).
- o Throughout Deputy ██████'s service as a Patrol Officer, Deputy ██████ obtained multiple additional training certificates in the field of Road Patrol.
