PETITION — PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CONSTITUTION OF OHIO — TO CHANGE SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF ARTICLE III — TO ADOPT AND ADD TO ARTICLE IV THREE NEW SECTIONS, i.e., SECTIONS 3-A, 7-A, 7-B AND TO ADOPT AND ADD TO ARTICLE X ELEVEN NEW SECTIONS, i.e., SECTIONS 8; 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 AND 18 — EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT — STATE OFFICERS — JUDICIARY — COUNTY OFFICERS.

Dear Sir:

You have submitted for my examination a written petition bearing over one hundred names, containing a proposed constitutional amendment and a summary of the same under section 4785-175, General Code. It is proposed to amend the Constitution of the State of Ohio by changing sections 1 and 2 of Article III; by adopting and adding to Article IV three

new sections (i.e., sections 3-A, 7-A and 7-B); and by adopting and adding to Article X eleven new sections (i.e., Sections 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18). Copies of said proposed constitutional amendment and summary thereof are hereto attached. (See File—Attorney General.)
