DETAILS:

On Wednesday, April 13, 2022 at approximately 0408hrs, SA Ornelas arrived at E. 46th Street, Ashtabula, Ohio 44004 and met with SA Justin Soroka in regard to an officer involved critical incident. It was advised that on the south side of the road near the intersection of Collins Blvd., there was a rifle belonging to an officer involved in the incident. Reportedly, the officer did not fire this rifle.

SA Ornelas photographed the rifle belonging to Ptl. Brandon Zukowski as it was found near cruiser P6 (Figure 1). It was in the safe position on top of a camouflage ballistic vest with a "POLICE" patch and camouflage jacket. A tripod spotting scope was next to the jacket and vest. The rifle was a Colt M4 Carbine Cal. 5.56mm bearing serial number [REDACTED] with a Specter DR telescope (Serial # 10-12514). One (1) cartridge was in the chamber and twenty-six (26) cartridges were in the magazine. After photographing, the rifle was returned to Ptl. Zukowski.
