EASEMENTS—PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS, TO STATE BY SEVERAL PROPERTY OWNERS, LANDS, MULENBERG AND DARBY TOWNSHIPS, PICKAWAY COUNTY.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio by several property owners in Mulenberg and Darby Townships, Pickaway County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said townships and county.

The grants of easement here in question, designed with respect to the number of the instrument and the name of the grantor, are as follows:
