On 06/21/2022, while processing the scene, S/A Hammond was alerted by Allen County Deputies that a woman needed to speak with a BCI Agent about a potential suspect who may have been in the car at the time of the traffic stop.

S/A Hammond spoke briefly to: Teresa A. McLaurin, 225 E. Vine Street, Lima, Ohio 45804, 614-905-8466.

She advised that she was at the home of Quincy Pritchett's grandmother on Essex Street. She advised that Quincy resided with her. While there, they received a phone call that George Pritchett may have been in the car at the time of the stop but fled the area before police could catch him. She advised that the person providing this information was Maurice "Sports" Reynolds (567-328-5044).

Mrs. McLaurin stated that George Pritchett was causing a lot of problems in the Lima area. She stated he was involved with drugs and some local shootings. She encouraged investigators to talk to George Pritchett.

S/A Hammond took down Mrs. McLaurin's information and provided it to SAS Stranahan for potential follow up investigation.
