DEAR SIR:—You have submitted to me for approval a contract (5 copies) between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Highways and Public Works, of the one part, and The John L. Walker Contracting Company, an Ohio Corporation, of Hamilton, Ohio, of the other part.
