said plat being now on file in the Division of Conservation and Natural Resources at Columbus, Ohio.

Upon examination of the leases hereinabove referred to, I find that the same have been properly executed by you as Commissioner, Division of Conservation and Natural Resources and by the lessees therein named.

I further find, upon examination of the provisions of these leases and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which these leases are executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving these leases, as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the leases and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereon, all of which are herewith inclosed. Respectfully,
