LEASE—RESERVOIR LAND, STATE TO D. J. STOLTZ, DESIGNATED LAND, ORCHARD ISLAND, BUCKEYE LAKE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, USE, COTTAGE SITE AND DOCKLANDING PURPOSES.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the State of Ohio, through you as Commissioner of the Division of Conservation and Natural Resources to D. J. Stoltz of Columbus, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen (15) years and which provides for an annual rental of \$39.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, permission to occupy and use for cottage site and docklanding purposes only, Lot No. 6, of the Subdivision of lands on Orchard Island in Buckeye Lake, as shown by the plat of C. H. Wells' allotment of lands on said island, made under the direction of the State Board of Public Works on the 8th day of August, 1908, and being part of the Southwest Section of Section 23, Town 17, Range 8 East, Fairfield County, Ohio—said plat being on file now in the Division of Conservation and Natural Resources at Columbus, Ohio, and to which reference is hereby made for further description.
