TO AMEND CONSTITUTION OF OHIO, TO ADD NEW SECTION 19B TO ARTICLE I—EMPLOYER-EMPLOYEE—LABOR—CLOSED SHOP OR OPEN SHOP.

You have submitted for my examination a written petition bearing over one hundred names containing a proposed constitutional amendment and a summary of the same under Section 4785-175, General Code. It is proposed to amend the Constitution of the State of Ohio by the adoption of the new section to be known as Section 19b, Article I.
