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APPROVAL—LEASE TO CERTAIN OFFICE ROOMS IN TOLEDO AND COLUMBUS, FOR USE OF THE DIVISION OF AID FOR THE AGED AND BUREAU OF OCCUPATIONAL DISEASES, DEPT. OF HEALTH.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, August 11, 1936.

HON. CARL G. WAHL, *Suprcintendent of Public Works, Columbus, Ohio.*

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my approval certain leases, as hereinafter set forth, granting to you, as Superintendent of Public Works, for the use of the Division of Aid for the Aged, Department of Public Welfare, and the Bureau of Occupational Diseases, Division of Hygiene, Department of Health, respectively, certain office rooms in several cities, as follows:

Lease from the Boody Building Co., Toledo, Ohio, for Rooms 301, 303, 304 and 305, of the Ohio Bank Building, Toledo, Ohio. This lease is for a term of six (6) months, beginning on the first day of July, 1936, and ending on the 31st day of December, 1936, by the terms of which the State is required to pay eighty-five dollars (\$85.00) per month rent.

Lease from the S. S. Kresge Co., Detroit, Michigan, for Rooms 415, 416 and 417 of the building known as "83 S. High St.," Columbus, Ohio. This lease is for a term of two (2) years, beginning on the first day of July, 1936 and ending on the 30th day of June, 1938, by the terms of which the State will be required to pay a rental of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per year.

You have submitted encumbrance estimates which contain the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that funds are available for the payment of rentals for at least two months of the term in each instance.

Proper evidence of authority is furnished to indicate the right of persons executing the leases to bind their respective principals.

Finding said leases in proper legal form, I hereby approve them as to form and return them herewith.
